



Private A Crawshaw

Mr and Mrs W. Crawshaw, of 250, Bolton Road, Bury, received official intimation on Wednesday that their son Private Albert Crawshaw, of the 8<sup>th</sup> Somerset Light Infantry, died of wounds in St. John's Hospital, Etaples, France, on Tuesday, February 14<sup>th</sup>. Pte. Crawshaw enlisted at the end of August 1915. He was 21 years of age and before enlisting worked in the iron foundry of Messrs. Bentley and Jackson. He was connected with St Stephen's Mission Church and had been a member of the football and cricket clubs for a number of years
