



Gunner Robert Nuttall

Mrs Nuttall, of 13 Park Street, Fernhill, Bury has received official intimation that her son, Gunner Robert Nuttall, of the Royal Field Artillery, has been killed in France. No details are given, but a comrade who enlisted at the same time, in a letter says he saw him being taken to a dressing station. Gunner Nuttall who was 25 years of age, enlisted on March 17th 1915 being at that time a carter in the cleansing department of the Bury Corporation and he was well respected. He had been connected with St John's Church and school but more recently with Chesham Unitarian School. He has a brother, Gunner George Nuttall, also with the Royal Field Artillery in France. George enlisted two days prior to Robert, and it was with the intention of looking after George that Robert enlisted.
