Mrs Rigby, of 43 Salford Street, Chesham, has received an official intimation of the death of her husband, Corporal Wilfred Rigby, who was killed in action on April 7<sup>th</sup>. Corporal Rigby, who was with the Manchester Pals' Regiment, was the son of Mr and Mrs J H Rigby, of Vernon Street, Bury, and was born 28 years ago. He was a plumber by trade, and served his time with Mr J. Y. Rigby, plumber. He was connected with Chesham Unitarian Church and school all his life, having attended both day and Sunday school. His name is on the roll of honour there. He was a member of the Duke of Wellington Lodge of Oddfellows (Manchester Unity). Corporal Rigby was married a year ago. His widow has received letters from the chaplain of the battalion and several brother N.C.O.'s expressing sympathy and appreciation of the manly and soldierly qualities of Corporal Rigby.
